April 2022 - March 2023

Our Peer support team organise and host regular coffee morning/support group events across North Somerset. These take place both in the daytime and evening providing peer support to Parent Carers of children and young people with additional needs and/or disabilities. These can be specific, general, themed and/or attended by guest organisations. We are continually developing this offer around Parent Carer needs and requests. For example, we run twice monthly support groups for parents of children with ADHD and/or ASC as a direct response to parent carer requests. Parent Carers of a child or young person with an 'emerging need' but without a diagnosis, are also welcome to attend any of our events.
